


Hollington Farm, Alma Farm, & Hollington Triangle

This walk, starting and ending at Woolton Hill Rec car park, is 3.5 miles and goes across lovely fields with wonderful views. (Contains Stiles)



- 1. Turn left out of the recreation ground car park and then left into Church Road following the road until it forks.
- 2. On your left you will see a large set of gates. Go through them and walk along the driveway of Hollington House until you reach a footpath sign on your right at Hollington Farm. Go through the gate and follow the path through two more gates and down the hill.
- 3. At the bottom, take the right-hand path. Go through the gate and follow the path up diagonally across the field. Go through the gate and turn right. Walk along the tree covered pathway until you come to Westridge.
- 4. Turn right. Follow the road until you come to the footpath on the right by Alma farm.
- 5. Go over the stile and go down the pathway, through a gate into a wooded area. In spring this area is delightful with a carpet of bluebells. Follow the path through the woods to an open area and cross diagonally. You will see the pheasantry on your right. Take a left pathway (not the vehicle track) up through the woods. Follow the path up through the woods to a small stile into a field. Cross the field until you come to Hollington Road.
- 6. Turn right and follow the road to the triangle. Take the right turn and follow the road back to Church Road. Follow Church Road until you come to the junction with woolton Hill Road. Turn right and you will see the car park on your right.
